

# Key knowledge

- Plants grow from seeds or bulbs.
- Germination is when a seed begins to grow and sprout.
- Flowers produce seeds which are transported by the wind or insects. They fall to the ground and begin the life cycle of a new plant.
- The stem carries water and nutrients around the plant.
- The leaves help the plant to make food from sunlight.
- Roots collect water and nutrients from the soil.
- Flowers have petals that are brightly coloured to attract wildlife.

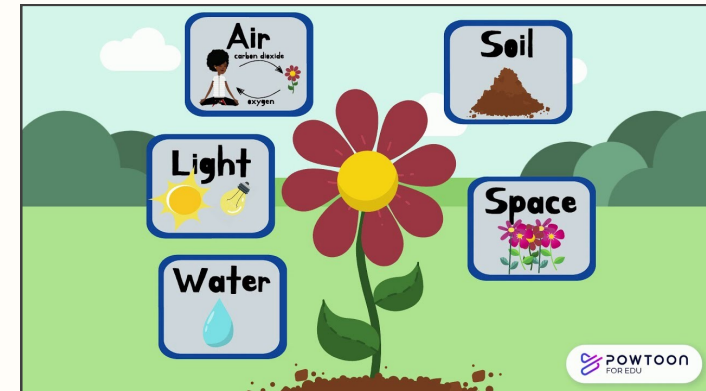
