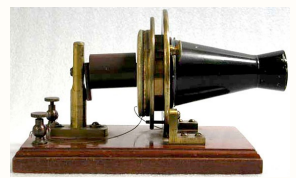

Key Knowledge

- Alexander Graham Bell was born in Edinburgh, Scotland on March 3, 1847.
 - Both his mother and wife were deaf, which influenced a lot of his inventions and ideas.
 - Bell moved from Scotland to America and then moved to Canada where he passed away in 1922.
 - Bell invented the first telephone and made his first phone call in 1876.
 - The term 'decibel' is named after Alexander Graham Bell? The unit for sound
- Technology refers to methods, systems, and devices which are the result of scientific knowledge being used for practical purposes.
- The first phone call came around in 1876 which allowed people to communicate with people close by and over seas.
 - Neil Papworth who sent the world's first text message on 3 December 1992.
 - On October 29th 1969, the first message was sent from computer to computer known as an email.
 - Social Media platforms began being released in 1997 and it still continuing to evolve now.
