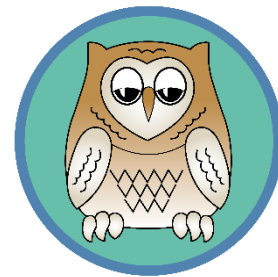

What is Child Protection about?

- We do our best to help you do your best in school
- We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations, and how to protect yourselves and stay safe

How will we try to protect you in school?

- We think it is important that you know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something

What do our children think?
